



Pool, Pavilion and Tennis Information

Pool

- Pool is open from 8 AM – 10 PM for Sweet Pine Creek residents, non-residents with a paid pool membership and **guests accompanied by a resident of at least 14 years of age.**
- Posted pool rules must be followed.
- Umbrellas must be left in the down position when leaving.
- Combination to the pool gate and bathrooms is 4, 2.

Pavilion

Tennis Courts

- For use from 8 AM – 10 PM by Sweet Pine Creek Residents and **accompanied** guests.
- Combination to the tennis court gate is 1, 5.
- Organized teams must register with the Tennis Coordinator, Holly Hannah.
- Non-resident team members must pay a \$50 annual non-resident tennis fee.
- Tennis courts may be reserved using the on-line reservation system at www.reservemycourt.com. Additional information on the website.
- With the exception of scheduled lessons, make-up matches for ALTA or other organized community based tennis teams take scheduling priority over practices, even if the practices have been scheduled in advance.

Cleaning Up After Using Facilities

After using the facilities with your family, tennis group or any other functions, please inspect all areas for trash and cleanliness including the creek, tree house and the restrooms. Please remove all trash bags even if they are not full and replace with new bags. Replacement trash bags are tied to the trash cans. Large trash containers are located in the parking lot near the basketball goal.

Leave the area cleaner than you found it!

Pavilion Cooking Area

- Plan ahead to ensure that there is adequate propane in the tanks prior to your event. The regulators for the tanks are designed to drain one tank at a time – ensure you have at least half of a tank remaining in at least one tank.
- Children are not allowed in the kitchen area without adult supervision. The gas grills could be very dangerous.

Directions for Lighting the Grills

1. Before lighting a grill, check the grill gas knobs to make sure they are both off.
2. Open the grill cover.
3. Turn on gas at the tanks (located inside the pool fence) first, and then turn on the knob to the grill you are lighting.
4. Light according to the directions on the slide-out tray at the bottom of each grill or using the separate instruction posted on the bulletin board.
5. After grilling your food, please turn the grill on high for 10 minutes to burn off the grease.
6. Turn off tank valves when finished.

Please turn off all lights, close propane tank valves and lock all doors and gates if you are the last to leave the area!
